1. **Minutes:** The October 18<sup>th</sup> minutes were approved.
2. **Monsignor’s report:**
  - a. Monsignor introduced Victor Yazbec and Dave Kulick who briefed the council on the renovation project.
  - b. The carpool lane at Palmer Academy has been completed which gets most of the traffic off CR 210
  - c. \$16,800 was received in the special collection for hurricane relief.  
This will assist the recovery for two parishes in Panama City.
  - d. CCW installed new officers at their initial meeting.
  - e. The Ministry fair on December 8 & 9<sup>th</sup> will be set up in the Gathering area and outside.
  - f. Advent retreat will be December 1<sup>st</sup> and Penance Service will be held on December 19<sup>th</sup>
  - g. Cultural Center renovation is nearing completion. Painting, tile and carpeting are done re-landscaping is underway.
  - h. Changes to the Church renovation design have been made in response to Parishioner’s comments.
  - i. Approval of the recommended design has been received from the Diocese
