- iii. The council commented on:

 - 2. possible content: Bishop Barron homilies, overlayment to myParish links and OLSS bulletin
- c. What are parishioners looking for: a deeper relationship with Christ. (Terry)
 - i. Provide more opportunities for parishioners to serve others/generosity/selfless giving.
 - ii. Closer connection with clergy
 - iii. Greater sense of community
 - 1. Fundraising
 - iv. Quality Council to investigate ministries' best practices.
 - v. Youth program investigate to invigorate/advertise more.
 - 1. Msgr. mentioned new youth minister is just now getting going.
 - vi. Msgr. comment, "Furthering parishioners to be engaged in their faith life". "Lots of gifts and talents in this parish. Are we utilizing them to the best degree".
 - vii. Terry commented on Bishop Barron's series on Catholicism where education like this series promotes a dive into faith.
 - viii. Msgr. mentions Feb 5th, Ministry Fair.
 - ix. Although there is an opportunity to get people involved; delve into more ways to get people involved and offer some recommendations.
 - x. Discussion ensued around the idea of ministries presenting their mission statement at designated masses.
 - xi. Msgr. mentioned 40 ministries at OLSS possibly discussing their mission statement; each one per week in the 52 wk yr. cycle.
 - xii. Msgr. mentioned Fr. Eric is chairing both the Diocesan committee for Eucharistic Revival, and head a chair on the Pastoral Council's committee for Eucharistic Revival within OLSS parish.
- b. Time and Talent for Volunteers Ministry (Mary Anne)
 - i. Msgr. mentions parish-level stewardship revival in a balanced approach to giving back to God for the gifts God has given us through a balanced gift of your time, money, and/or talent.
 - ii. Upon Mary Anne's return, Msgr. to ask her to lead a committee on Stewardship in the parish.
