3. Review of October 26, 2023 Meeting Minutes

5. Committees Reports

- a. **Bylaws**: In the absence of committee chair, James McGuire, Paul Jennings mentioned that they have met and the committee is reviewing the 2015 and 2019 versions of the PC's Bylaws. The committee intensely reviewed the latest bylaws version to determine if it meets the Council's needs. The committee reported identified approx. 6 topics and may be recommending adding 1-2 topics to the bylaws.
 - i. Monsignor added that from the onset, the Bishop's template bylaws and OLSS's PC bylaws were seemingly in concert as both appear formulated from the book, *Making Parish Councils Pastoral* by Mark Fischer.
- b. **Evangelization**: Jill Rattigan indicated the committee has reviewed the Bishop's commissioned work on Evangelization via powerpoint.
 - i. The committee continues to identify some other parishioners, not part of the council, to add to the committee.
 - ii. The committee reported to the PC on whether they should approach ministry leaders to review the Evangelization powerpoint to brainstorm ideas for parish evangelization.
 - 1. Sister Lucy and Msgr. indicated that it would be historically consistent if there was more information shared later from the Bishop's office as a follow-up from the presentation.

 Msgr. indicated he liked the idea of getting people together and sharing the presentation, but be forthright that more direction from the Bishop's office is expected.
 - 2. Msgr. confirmed the committee's suggestion that it is appropriate to research this topic with the Diocesan office to confirm if and when further direction on evangelization may be coming.
- c. **Electronic Communications Committee**: Ben Luke and John Harrington reported we have launched a survey to collect the pros, cons, wants, and needs of the current parish communication efforts. We've asked the PC members to also complete it and critique its construction and methodology.
 - i. We've reported that we wish to distribute this survey to the ministry heads to complete and share with their members.

- ii. We also wish to distribute the survey to parishioners via aQR code handout after masses.

- iv. Msgr introduced the question of what will be a statistically valid population to approach and to receive results back. The electronic communication committee will investigate and incorporate this to validate our research.
